Ofcom is changing the way you'll be charged for calling 084 and 087 in order to make the cost of calls clearer.

New rates apply for 084, 087 from July 1st

Ofcom is changing the way you'll be charged for calling 084 and 087 in order to make the cost of calls clearer.

The new cost of calling service numbers 084 & 087 is made up of two parts:

An access charge: This part of the call charge goes to your phone company, charged as pence per minute. They will tell you how much the access charge will be for calls to service numbers. It will be made clear on bills and when you take out a contract.

A service charge: This is the rest of the call charge. The organisation you are calling decides this, and will tell you how much it is.

Freespeech has an access charge of 10p per min.

The service charge will depend on the number called.

Ofcom states the service charge for calls to 084 numbers can be between 0p and 7p per minute.

Ofcom states the service charge for calls to 087 numbers can be between 0p and 13p per minute.
